## **Frequently Asked Questions**



### FAQs:

#### General Authority of Zakat and Tax (GAZT)

#### Q1: What types of taxes are covered by the Initiative?

Postponement and suspension cover all types of tax returns (VAT, Excise Tax, and Income Tax) as well as zakat returns, effective from the initiative launch date.

#### Saudi Customs

## Q2: Are there any terms & conditions to be adhered to by an importer?

Yes, an importer shall submit an application via Saudi Customs Portal, provide a Bank Guarantee to Commercial Register through any SAMA-approved bank, provided that guarantee covers all imports during the postponement period.

#### **General Organization for Social Insurance**

#### Q3: How does an employee know if s\he is one of the 70% who can benefit from compensation?

If a support request submitted by an entity has been accepted, an SMS will be sent to the subscriber on the mobile number registered on "Absher" to apply for SANED compensation. Both employer and employee should verify contact numbers.

### Q4: If the employee is a subscriber covered by support, how can s\he apply?

Requests will be submitted through the subscriber's account on the GOSI website.

#### Q5: When will requests for compensation start?

Enterprises can submit requests for support from Wednesday, April 8.

If the support request submitted by the enterprise has been accepted, an SMS will be sent to the subscriber to apply for SANED compensation. The compensation will be released from the beginning of the month following submission and processing of application.

#### **Ministry of Commerce**

Q6: Do such initiatives include all Saudi, foreign and Gulf registrations?

Yes.

#### Q7: Can a customer renew for a longer period?

Yes.

#### Q8: Should the customer undertake any action?

No. All registrations ending within the specified period have been renewed and the customer has been notified of renewal.

## Q9 : Which consumption categories are subject to the decision to reduce bills by 30%?

The decision will be applied to commercial, industrial and agricultural consumption.

#### Q10: Will reduction be made for all months?

No, reduction applies on April and May 2020 bills only.

## Q11: Will 50% reduction for bills paid in (April, May and June) be made automatically?

No, if a customer wants to pay 50% of his bill, he should enter 50% of the bill value through banking channels.

## Q12: Can both 30% reduction and 50% payment initiatives be used at the same time?

Yes, they can be used simultaneously, as 30% of consumption value will be reduced automatically for April and May bills, and then the bill will be issued. Further, the subscriber can pay at least 50% of the bill value after such reduction.

#### Q13: Who are the beneficiaries? Are there any conditions to be met to be eligible for the Deferred Payments Program?

All MSMEs per SAMA Circular No. 381000064902 dated 16/06/1438H. Such beneficiaries can benefit from the program according to Kafalah Program, and subject to the policies of granting credit to financiers cooperating with Kafalah Program.

#### Q14: How can a beneficiary know if the credit facilities granted are supported by SAMA under the program?

Upon granting credit facilities, the financier must, in writing, notify the program beneficiaries that the financing cost is supported by the Guaranteed Facility Program.

## Q15: When can the financier benefit from the amount allocated for the Program?

Finance companies can benefit from the program after signing the necessary agreements with SAMA and when submitting the drawdown request. On the other hand, banks can submit the drawdown request through the automated system between SAMA and banks according to the procedures followed in the Treasury Department.

#### Q16: What is the minimum amount of drawdown from the Program amount, and how many drawdown requests can be submitted by a financier to benefit from the Program?

The minimum amount is SAR 10 million, and any number of drawdown requests can be submitted, provided that the conditions in the agreement are met.
